

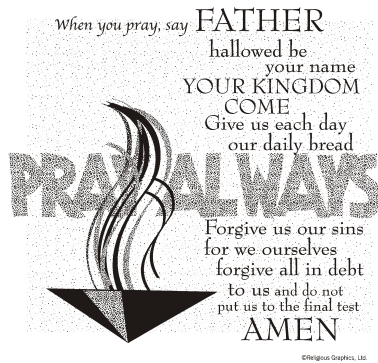

The disciples could see that when Jesus prayed it was an altogether different experience from the praying they knew. What he taught was not so much a form of words as a new relationship with God. Just as we would expect our children to be given good things from their earthly father, so we, as God's children, can trustingly ask and expect to receive good things from our heavenly Father.

It is sometimes helpful to think of the Lord's Prayer as headings, and spend much longer on each phrase than is usual, remembering throughout each phrase and silence, that God is our loving Father we are conversing with him as his loving children.
