Much better for us to recognize God as the source of everlasting richness, and break our dependency on physical wealth. Then we shall be able to enjoy the created world without being enslaved to it.

Jesus' parable exaggerates the contrast between assumed and actual security to drive home the foolishness of relying on temporal things as if they were permanent. Our lives as Christians should proclaim a far better, richer and more fulfilling alternative. But if we merely say these things and yet live as materialistically as everyone else, how can we ever expect people to believe us?
